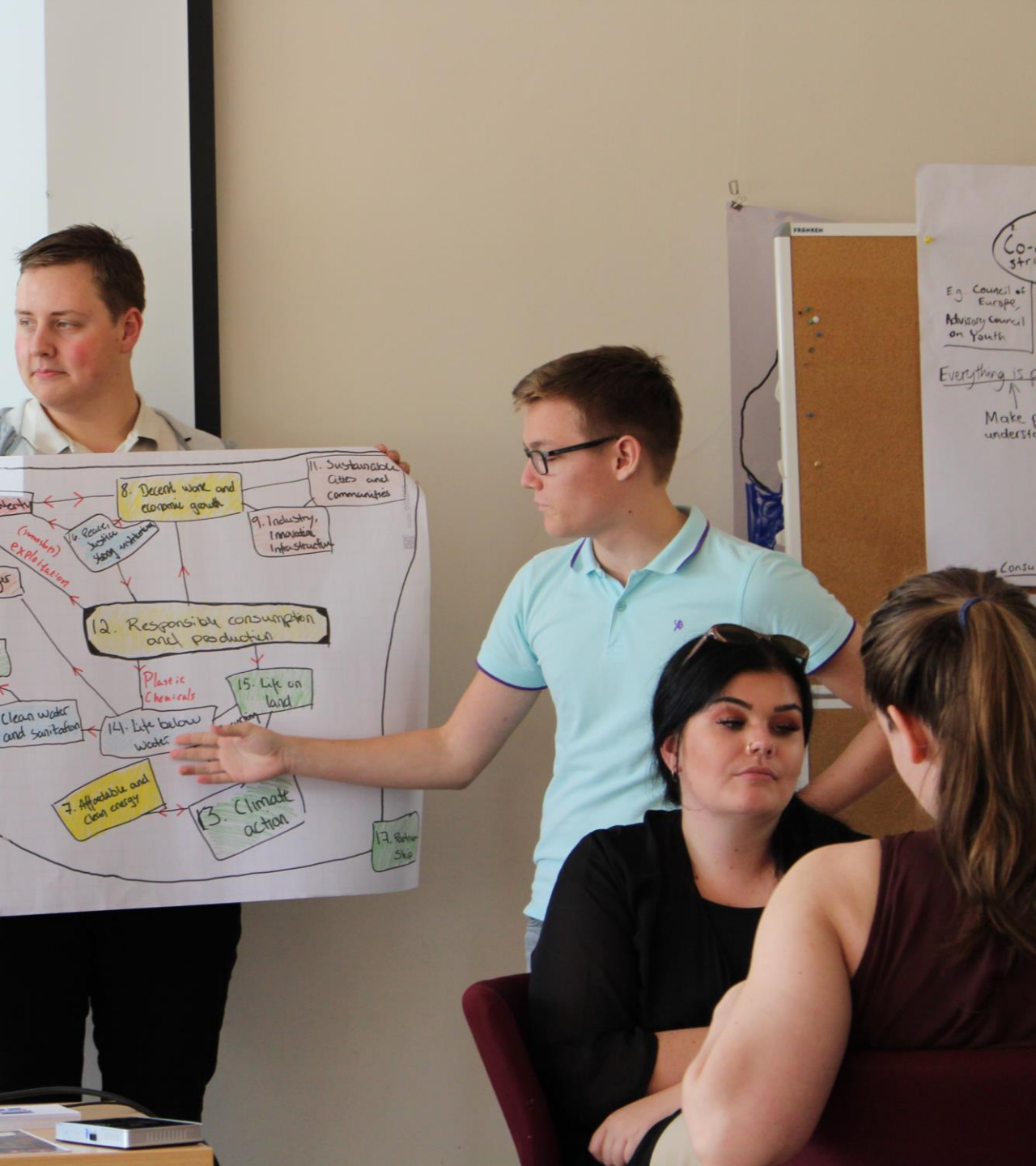

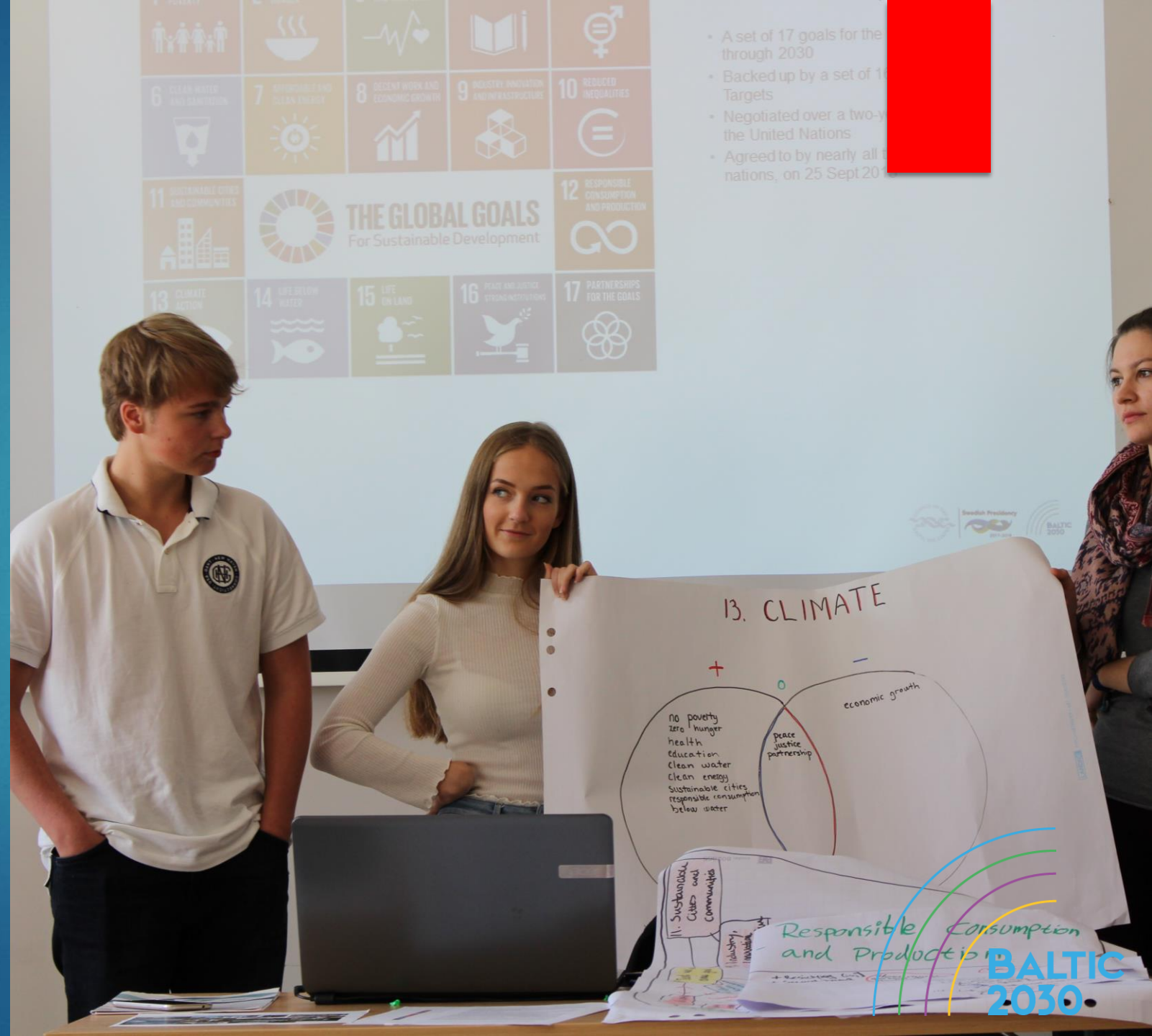


1. Partnerships for sustainable development
