



## DEVELOPMENT AND SUSTAINABILIVTY AGENDA FOR ÅLAND

- Milestone 2014, the Åland parliament and the Åland government chose to adopt a common pursuit of total sustainable development in Åland no later than 2051.
- September 2015, UN member states formally adopt the *Agenda 2030*
- Beginning of 2016, the network bärkraft.ax, including the Development and Sustainability Council is established at the initiative of operators from the public sector, the business community, associations and the educational sector.
- September 2016, the launch of *The Development and Sustainability Agenda for Åland,* open for everyone / supported by an expert panel/developed by hundreds of people.
- September 2017, the first Progress report is presented during the second *Social Forum*


